TIME AND METHOD OF IDENTIFICATION.

(2) Live puppies or kittens, less than 16 weeks of age, shall be identified by:

- (i) An official tag as described in Sec. 2.51;
- (ii) A distinctive and legible tattoo marking approved by the Administrator; or
- (iii) A plastic-type collar acceptable to the Administrator which has legibly placed thereon the information required for an official tag pursuant to Sec. 2.51.

There were multiple puppies under 16 weeks of age that were separated from the mothers that did not have proper Id or cage cards. While each primary enclosure did have a cage card identifying the number and sex of the puppies, there was no individual Id number, description or sex assigned to each individual puppy.

Complete identification information is necessary on weaned puppies in order to keep proper record management and care of the regulated animals.

The licensee must provide proper identification via tags, tattoo, plastic-type collar or cage card according to regulation sec. 2.51 for any puppies less than 16 weeks of age once separated from the female.
